## MATERIALS:

3/4 yard Cities Navy, binding

1-5/8 yards Peonies Navy

1-1/4 yards Peonies Butter

1-1/3 yards Cities Orange

2-3/8 yards Fireflies Navy

1-1/4 yards Fireflies White

Backing: 6-1/3 yards (40" WOF)

or 2-1/2 yards (108" WOF)

Batting: 90" x 90"

## RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

Creative Grids, The Big Easy 12-1/2" x 24-1/2"

Creative Grids 8-1/2" Square Ruler

Bloc Loc 5" x 10" Flying Geese Ruler

*READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING THIS PROJECT. FABRICS ARE SEWN RIGHT-SIDES TOGETHER USING A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT.*

*WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER; HST = HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE; FG = FLYING GEESE*

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

### From Peonies Navy Fabric:

Cut [4] — 5-1/8" × WOF strips

Subcut [12] — 5-1/8" squares, **Unit H**

Subcut [12] — 5-1/8" squares, **Unit J**

Subcut [4] — 4-1/2" × 8-1/2" rectangles, **Unit D**

Cut [12] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips, Inside Border and Frame

### From Peonies Butter Fabric:

Cut [4] — 4-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [4] — 4-1/2" squares, **Unit B**

Subcut [16] — 4-1/2" × 8-1/2" rectangles, **Unit C**

Cut [2] — 9-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [3] — 9-1/2" squares, **Unit J**

Subcut [3] — 9-1/2" squares, **Unit L**

### From Cities Orange Fabric:

Cut [1] — 8-1/2" × WOF strip

Subcut [4] — 8-1/2" squares, **Unit F**

Cut [1] — 5-1/8" × WOF strip

Subcut [4] — 5-1/8" squares, **Unit M**

Cut [1] — 12-5/8" × WOF strip

Subcut [2] — 12-5/8" squares, **Unit P**

Subcut [2] — 6-5/8" squares, **Unit Q**

Cut [8] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips, Middle Border

### From Fireflies Navy Fabric:

Cut [1] — 8-1/2" × WOF strip

Subcut [4] — 4-1/2" × 8-1/2" rectangles, **Unit E**

Subcut [1] — 8-1/2" square, **Unit G**

Cut [3] — 5-1/8" × WOF strips

Subcut [8] — 5-1/8" squares, **Unit K**

Subcut [12] — 5-1/8" squares, **Unit L**

Cut [8] — 6-1/2" × WOF strips, Outside Border

### From Fireflies White Fabric:

Cut [3] — 4-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [20] — 4-1/2" squares, **Unit A**

Cut [2] — 9-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [3] — 9-1/2" squares, **Unit H**

Subcut [2] — 9-1/2" squares, **Unit K**

Subcut [1] — 9-1/2" square, **Unit M**

Cut [1] — 7" × WOF strip

Subcut [4] — 7" squares, **Unit N**

### From Cities Navy Fabric:

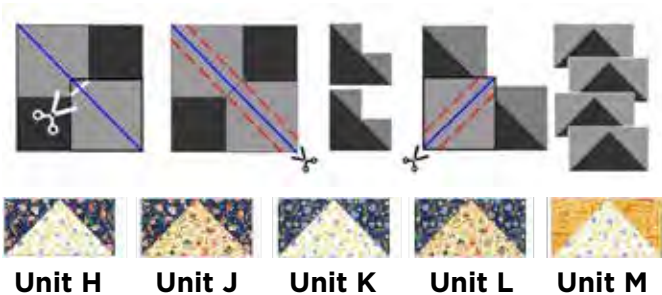
Cut [9] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips, Binding

## BLOCK CONSTRUCTION:

### 4-At-A-Time Flying Geese:

Pair the following fabrics to create the smaller Flying Geese:

- **Unit H:** [12] Peonies Navy with [3] Fireflies White = Yields [12] FG
- **Unit J:** [12] Peonies Navy with [3] Peonies Butter = Yields [12] FG
- **Unit K:** [8] Fireflies Navy with [2] Fireflies White = Yields [8] FG
- **Unit L:** [12] Fireflies Navy with [3] Peonies Butter = Yields [12] FG
- **Unit M:** [4] Cities Orange with [1] Fireflies White = Yields [4] FG



1. Draw a diagonal line (corner to corner) on the wrong side of all the small squares.
2. Note the drawn line, place [2] small squares RST in opposite corners of a large square.
3. Clip the overlapping center to remove bulk. Do not cut through to the large square.
4. Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.
5. Cut on the drawn line.
6. Open and press towards the small triangles.
7. On each of the [2] units created, place a small square RST matching the bottom corner. Note the direction of the drawn line.
8. Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.
9. Cut on the drawn line.
10. Open and press towards the small triangles. Yield: [4] Flying Geese.
11. Use the Bloc Loc Flying Geese ruler or your favorite quilting ruler to trim. Units H through M measure 4" x 8" Finished (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Unfinished).

### Side Triangles:

1. **Unit N:** [4] Fireflies White 7" square = Yields [16] triangles  
Cut each square twice diagonally creating [4] triangles each.
2. **Unit P:** [2] Cities Orange 12-5/8" square = Yields [8] triangles  
Cut each square twice diagonally creating [4] triangles each.

### Corner Triangles:

1. **Unit Q:** [2] Cities Orange 6-5/8" square = Yields [4] triangles  
Cut each square once diagonally creating [2] triangles each.

### Corner Block:

1. Gather [4] Cities Orange 8-1/2" squares Unit F, [8] Peonies Butter 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles Unit C and [4] Fireflies White 4-1/2" squares, Unit A. Sew together as shown, first sewing into rows. Then, sewing rows together. Make [4].



### Crown Block:

1. Gather [12] Unit H Flying Geese, [4] Unit J Flying Geese, [4] Peonies Navy 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles Unit D and [8] Fireflies White 4-1/2" squares, Unit A. Sew together as shown, first sewing into rows. Then, sewing rows together. Make [4].



### Center Block:

1. Gather [4] Peonies Butter 4-1/2" squares Unit B, [4] Unit L Flying Geese, and [1] Fireflies Navy 8-1/2" square Unit G. Sew together as shown, first sewing into rows. Then, sewing rows together. Make [1].



## Center Triangle Units:

1. Gather [8] Cities Orange triangles Unit P, [4] Cities Orange triangles Unit Q, [16] Fireflies triangles Unit N, [8] Flying Geese Unit K, [8] Flying Geese Unit M, [8] Fireflies White Unit A, [8] Peonies Butter Unit C and [4] Fireflies Navy  $4\text{-}1/2" \times 8\text{-}1/2"$  rectangles, Unit K. Sew together as shown, first sewing into rows. Then, sewing rows together. Make [4].



## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

1. Layout completed blocks as shown. Sew rows together. Press.
2. Sew neighboring rows together matching seams. Press.



3. **Framing:** Uses Peonies Navy  $2\text{-}1/2" \times$  WOF strips sew together end to end. Press. Cut as follows or to measurements of quilt top center.  
Subcut [2] side borders  $2\text{-}1/2" \times 40\text{-}1/2"$   
Subcut [2] top/bottom borders  $2\text{-}1/2" \times 44\text{-}1/2"$
4. To attach the frame border to the center block, first sew the side borders. Press. Then, sew the top and bottom borders. Press.
5. Attach the [4] corner blocks to the sides. To ensure the corner blocks are positioned correctly, match the seam lines across the blue border. The corner blocks do not meet the end of the blue border. Press.
6. Trim the small triangle off the blue border to create a continuous edge on your quilt.

## BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. Follow the same method of sewing borders end to end, subcutting to listed or actual measurement, and attaching to quilt top center.

**Border 2:** Peonies Navy  $2\text{-}1/2" \times$  WOF strips  
Subcut [2] side borders  $2\text{-}1/2" \times 60"$   
Subcut [2] top/bottom borders  $2\text{-}1/2" \times 64"$

**Border 3:** Cities Orange  $2\text{-}1/2" \times$  WOF strips  
Subcut [2] side borders  $2\text{-}1/2" \times 64"$   
Subcut [2] top/bottom borders  $2\text{-}1/2" \times 68"$

**Border 4:** Fireflies Navy  $6\text{-}1/2" \times$  WOF strips  
Subcut [2] side borders  $6\text{-}1/2" \times 68"$   
Subcut [2] top/bottom borders  $6\text{-}1/2" \times 80"$



## FINISHING:

1. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind
4. Label & Enjoy!
