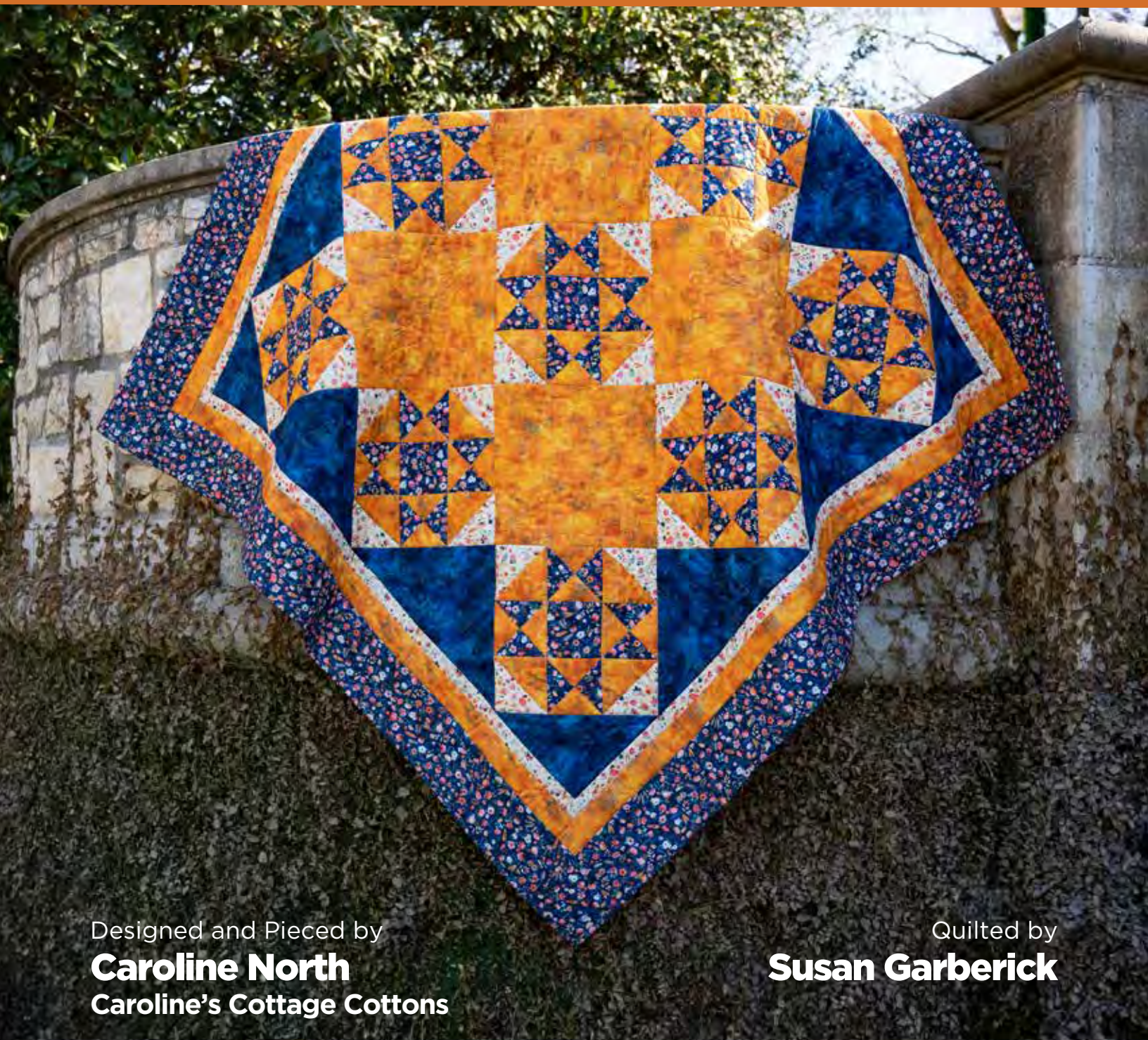


Swamp Angel

MATERIALS:

2-1/8 Yards Peonies Navy, includes binding

3/4 Yard Peonies Butter

2 Yards Blender Tangerine

1 Yards Blender Denim

4 Yards Blender Oatmeal (40" WOF)
or 2 Yards 108" WOF of Fabric of your
choice for backing

72" x 72" Batting

*READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS
BEFORE STARTING THIS PROJECT. FABRICS
ARE SEWN RIGHT-SIDES TOGETHER USING
A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT.*

*WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; RST = RIGHT
SIDES TOGETHER; QST = QUARTER SQUARE
TRIANGLE.*

*PRESS SEAMS TO DARKEST FABRIC,
AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE.
SQUARE ALL BLOCKS TO 4-1/2". FINAL
UNFINISHED BLOCK SQUARES TO 12-1/2".*

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From Peonies Navy Fabric:

Cut [18] — 5-1/2" squares, cut in half diagonally
twice, yielding [72] triangles **(A)**

Cut [9] — 4-1/2" squares **(C)**

Cut [7] — 5" x WOF strips, Third Border

Cut [7] — 2-1/2" x WOF strips, Binding

From Peonies Butter Fabric:

Cut [18] — 4-7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally
once, yielding [36] triangles **(B)**

Cut [6] — 1-1/2" x WOF strips, First Border

From Blender Tangerine Fabric:

Cut [18] — 4-7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally
once, yielding [36] triangles **(D)**

Cut [18] — 5-1/2" squares, cut in half diagonally
twice, yielding [72] triangles **(E)**

Cut [7] — 2-1/2" x WOF strips, Second Border

Cut [4] — 12-1/2" squares, Setting Blocks

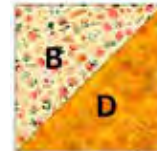
From Blender Denim Fabric:

Cut [2] — 18-1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally
twice, yielding [8] triangles for Side Setting
Triangles

Cut [2] — 9-3/8" squares, cut in half diagonally
once, yielding [4] triangles for Corner Triangles

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION:

1. Sew a **(B)** triangle to a **(D)** triangle, RST
to make a 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make
[4] units.



2. Sew an **(A)** triangle to an **(E)** triangle as
shown to make a QST unit. Make [4] units.



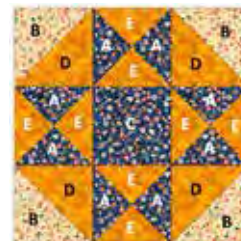
3. Sew an **(A)** triangle to an **(E)** triangle as
shown to make an additional QST unit.
Make [4] units



4. Sew the QST units from Steps 2 and 3, into
[4] units, as shown. Trim to 4-1/2".



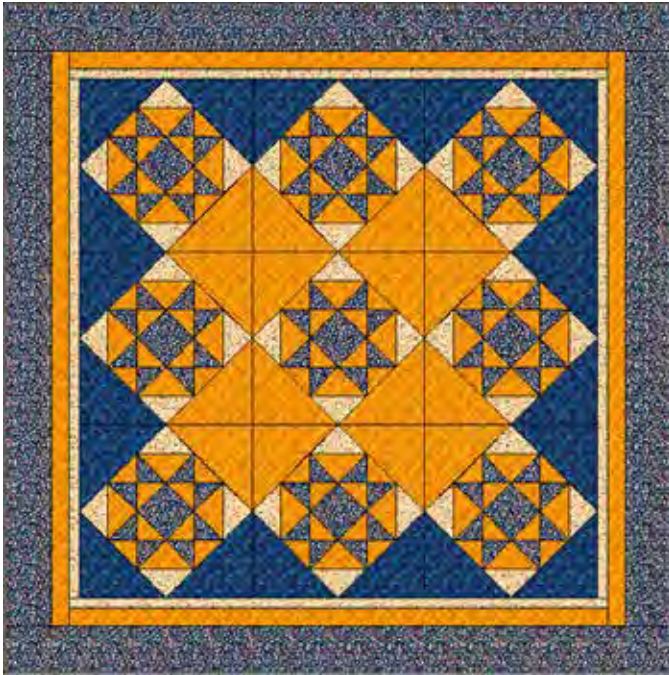
5. Using the units from Steps 1 and 4 along with
Peonies Navy 4-1/2" squares **(C)**, layout as
shown, to assemble the Swamp Angel Block.
Sew the block into [3] rows. Then sew the
rows together.



6. Repeat Steps 1 - 5 to make a total of [9]
Swamp Angel Blocks.

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

1. Referring to the quilt diagram, set the quilt blocks, side, and corner triangles, on the diagonal. If needed, make sure the quilt is square, and trim all of the setting triangles, making sure to leave 1/4" beyond the joining of the rows.



BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. Stitch the Peonies Butter 1-1/2" × WOF strips together, using the diagonal, piecing, method.
2. Sew side borders.
3. Then sew on the top and bottom borders. Press seams toward the outside of the quilt.
4. Repeat Steps 1-3 using the Blender Tangerine 2-1/2" × WOF strips for the Second border.
5. Repeat Steps 1-3 using the Peonies Navy 5" × WOF strips for the Third border.

FINISHING:

1. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind
4. Label & Enjoy!
